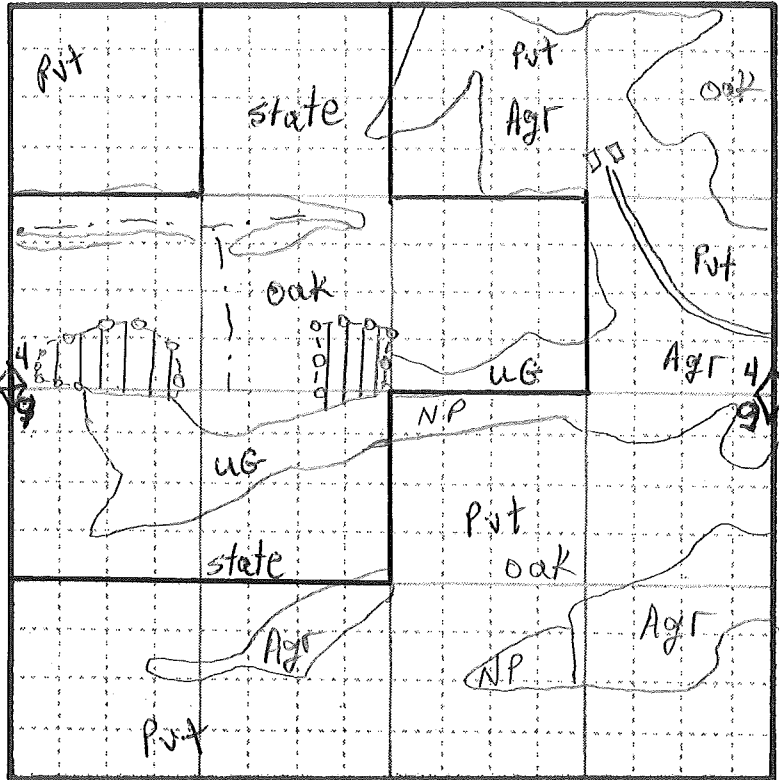
o-o-o Blue paint sale boundary

Roads & landing locations & closure must be approved by Forester. This sale must be cut during the period between Oct. 15, 1991 & Mar. 15, 1992.
